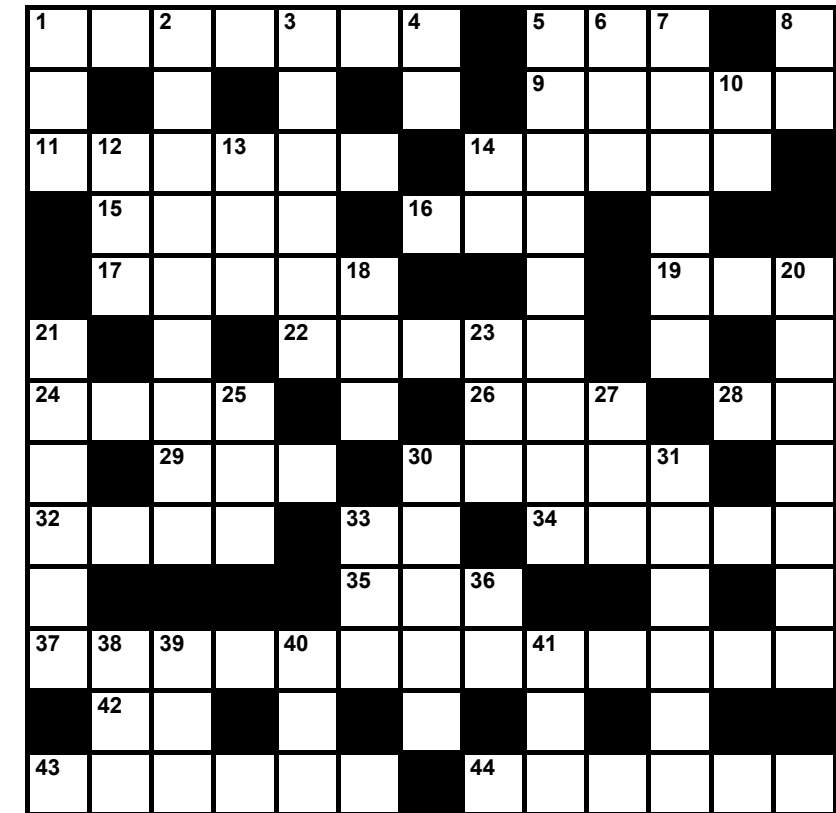
Welcome to our first medicine-related crossword, a new occasional feature in the *BCMj*.
